MEMBERSHIP HIGHLIGHTS

Membership by the Numbers



Since February

- Increase from 60 to 200 voting organizational members
- 17 non-voting Advisors
- Industry association members increase from 5 to 36
- Private sector personnel members increase by 272, from 58 up to 330
- Government personnel at 56, representing 7 federal agencies and 51 personnel, and one member each from 3 state agencies; 1 county and 1 city organization.

- Direct Patient Care: 108 (50%)
- Health Information Technology: 22 (10.2%)
- Health Plans and Payers: 18 (8.3%)
- Mass fatality and Management Services: 0
- Medical Materials: 25 (11.6%)

- Public Health: 16 (7.4%)
- Cross-sector: 3 (1.4%)



What's Ahead



Continued 2019 pursuit of objectives formed into outcome-specific task groups focused on implementing 2017 Healthcare Industry Cyber Security Task Force recommendations:

- 1. Define and streamline leadership, governance, and expectations for healthcare industry cybersecurity.
- 2. Increase the security and resilience of medical devices and health IT
- 3. Develop the healthcare workforce capacity necessary to prioritize and ensure cybersecurity awareness and technical capabilities
- 4. Increase healthcare industry readiness through improved cybersecurity awareness and education
- 5. Identify mechanisms to protect R&D efforts and intellectual property from attacks and exposure
- 6. Improve information sharing of industry threats, risks, and mitigations

2019 Initiatives Under Consideration



- International engagement and policy (Standing): Engage with CIP sector groups in other regions; explore partnerships and best practices, policy coordination
- <u>Security clearances (Single Task)</u>: Work with HHS to determine policy and process for health sector security clearances
- Incident Response Roles & Responsibilities (Single Task): Consider whether the HSCC CWG should participate in cyber incident response activity relative to H-ISAC and ISAOs, and if so, how: respective roles and responsibilities
- <u>Sector Specific Plan Update (Single Task)</u>: Joint HSCC / HHS drafting team to update cybersecurity portions of SSP
- <u>Communication and Collaboration Tools (Single Task)</u>: Explore and develop recommendations for effective communication and collaboration tools for CWG
- <u>Emerging Healthcare Technologies Cyber Risks</u>: Inventory and assessment with DHS National Risk Management Center
- <u>Membership Development</u>: Assess percentage of HSCC cross-sector representation and develop recruitment strategy





- Follows Financial Services and Electric Sector Models
- Aligns with Health Care Industry Cyber Security Task Force recommendation for HHS CEO Engagement
- Provides ability to align strategic initiatives in other forums
- Ability to raise resources
- Strategic advisor to SCC; Elevates discipline on deliverables

2019 Strategic Plans & Measures

- Strengthened "culture of leadership" in CWG:
 - EC leadership routinely identifying and recruiting new leaders within membership
- Expanded cross-sector representation of largest subsector stakeholders
- Increased membership and participation of senior executive decision-makers
- Task Group work products distributed and endorsed by relevant national industry associations; adopted by market movers
- Collaborative mechanisms for measuring adoption, implementation and results across relevant subsectors

Leadership Measures

- Increased demand (exceeding supply) for Chairs/Execcom/TG leadership roles
- Formation of plan for 2020 CEO Council
- Increase "proactive thinking" and organizational in-kind contributions
- Average 50% attendance in TG workstreams
- Two member contributions to website per month
- Increased traffic on webchat platform

Representation Measures

- Subsector representation each at 85% of market (metric to be defined)
- % of member representative titles at VP or above / % increase of that figure over 2018

 At least the 2 largest associations by membership per subsector distributing/endorsing relevant work products with follow-up monitoring and measuring plan.
